Information and Policies



The After School Enrichment Program at Mahomet-Seymour CUSD#3 consists of a variety of engaging enrichment and recreation classes. Students may participate in courses offered at their current school only.

How to Register: Go to the district website at www.ms.k12.il.us. Click on "Menu" in the upper left corner, then "For Parents", then choose "Online Store". Once in the Web Store find the B.L.A.S.T. icon. Please see the attached sheet for specific online registration instructions. Paper registration forms will be available in school offices. Online registration is credit card payment only. Paper registration will accept checks only. We encourage everyone to take advantage of online registration for BLAST! Paper registration will be accepted, but may take longer to process.

Confirmation: Registration and payment will be confirmed by e-mail immediately following the online registration process.

Minimum/Maximum Enrollment: A minimum number of students is required for each course and is noted in the course description. If the minimum enrollment is not met the class will be cancelled and a full refund will be given. A maximum number of students is set for each class to preserve quality education. We will do our best to serve as many students as possible without compromising quality.

Fees: A fee will be charged per class. Fees will be waived for those who qualify. Students qualifying for free/reduced lunch waivers are eligible for fee waivers for our B.L.A.S.T. program. However, we do not want to exclude any child, due to financial hardship, so we are offering a limited number of scholarships. If the student is eligible for a fee waiver, please indicate this on the registration form. All information will remain confidential.

Refund Request: Refund requests must be received before the first day of class.

Student Behavior: Students attending B.L.A.S.T. classes must follow their school's code of behavior. Parents will be notified if their child is not behaving properly. If inappropriate behavior continues the instructor has the right to dismiss the student from class. Continued incidents of misbehavior could result in dismissal from all remaining BLAST sessions.

Kid's Club Students: Students enrolled in Kid's Club may enroll in B.L.A.S.T. classes. Kid's Club students will proceed straight to their B.L.A.S.T. class after school. When B.L.A.S.T. classes are finished children will then proceed to Kid's Club.

Pick-up Procedures: At the end of B.L.A.S.T. programming children will be escorted to the designated pick-up location at their school. **Sangamon:** Front (North) door on Main Street. **Lincoln Trail:** The pick-up lane on the east side of the building, Dorchester Drive. Please wait in your car for your child at these locations. Kid's Club students will return to Kid's Club.

Class Cancellation: In the unlikely event that a class has to be cancelled on a day it is scheduled (i.e. instructor illness, inclement weather) students and parents will be notified as soon as possible. If school is canceled due to inclement weather, B.L.A.S.T. classes will not be held. If <u>more than one</u> class is missed, all attempts will be made to schedule a make-up class.




Select the B.L.A.S.T. button



- Click on the B.L.A.S.T button located on the Home Page.
- Select the specific School and class for which you wish to register.
- Select "Click Here to Register" to proceed with the registration process.
- If you have not already logged into or created a RevTrak account, you will be prompted to do so now using your Email Address and Password.
- Select the <u>exact participant</u>* you wish to register for the selected class. You may also select "A New Person" if they are not currently listed in your account.

*NOTE: The selected participant MUST be the name of the person attending the class.





 Answer <u>ALL</u> required questions before clicking the Check Out or Continue Shopping* buttons at the bottom of the page.

*NOTE: If you choose Continue Shopping to add additional registrations to your shopping cart, simply select the Checkout button when you have finished all necessary registrations.
